Fiscal Year 2009 Project Requests (Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies)

- \$808,000 for the planning and design of a new billeting facility at Camp Murray, Washington. This 31,835 square foot, 74-bed, multi-purpose facility would serve soldiers, airmen, emergency responders and emergency management at Camp Murray, and include parking, force protection, storage and administrative space; Washington National Guard.
- \$2.731 million to renovate the historic 1909 Tacoma Readiness Center; Washington National Guard.
- \$8.6 million for the construction of a facility for the 262nd Information Warfare Aggressor Squadron (IWAS) at McChord Air Force Base.
