SUBJECT: Coverage for Extra Prescriptions during Disaster Declaration FEMA DR-1969 Resulting from North Carolina Severe Storms, Tornadoes, and Flooding on April 16, 2011

This bulletin pertains to all insurers of health benefit plans as defined in G.S. 58-3-167, the State Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees, any optional plans or programs operating under Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes, and other stand-alone prescription medication plans issued by entities that are licensed by the N.C. Department of Insurance (hereinafter, "Department").

This bulletin serves as notice under G.S. 58-3-228(b) of a declared state of *disaster* in North Carolina due to North Carolina Severe Storms, Tornadoes, and Flooding on April 16, 2011. On April 20, 2011, a state of *disaster* was declared by the President for the following counties.

Bertie, Bladen, Craven, Cumberland, Currituck, Greene, Halifax, Harnett, Hertford, Hoke, Johnston, Lee, Onslow, Pitt, Robeson, Sampson, Wake, and Wilson.

For a covered person who resides in an affected county and who requests coverage of a refill or replacement prescription within 29 days of the date of this bulletin, the insurer shall have a procedure in place to waive time restrictions on filling or refilling prescriptions for medications. The insurer shall authorize payment to pharmacies for any prescription dispensed in accordance with G.S. 58-3-228 regardless of the date upon which the prescription had most recently been filled by a pharmacist.
