The U.S. Service Academies - Air Force, Naval, West Point, Merchant Marine, and Coast Guard - accept students through a congressional nomination process. To be eligible for my nomination, applicants must be an unmarried, United States citizen, between the ages of 17-23, with a high school education or equivalent, demonstrate high academic achievement, earn competitive scores on the SAT, and a participant in extracurricular and/or community endeavors highlighting leadership qualities.

Regardless of which agency you need help with, I am required by the Privacy Act to obtain prior written authorization to inquire on your behalf. ## Defense Department Adopts New Policy for Seriously Injured Servicemen

The Department of Defense recently announced a new procedure to expedite service members who are seriously injured in combat from military to veteran status. This allows veterans to receive benefits in three to four months in comparison to the traditional lengthy process.
