• PINK SLIPPING 13% OF OUR WARFIGHTERS

Roughly 200,000 active duty service members will have to leave service. This would be the equivalent of eliminating the entire Marine Corps.

• "BRAC"-ING MILITARY RETIREMENT

Payment of full retired pay until age 57 or 60 could be delayed, and benefits payable for 20+ years of service could be significantly reduced.

• DEVASTATING MONTANA'S ECONOMY

Under defense cuts, 1,953 jobs could be lost in Montana and our state could lose \$82 million in Gross State Product.
