CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make corrections in the enrollment of H.R. 3672.

1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate

2 concurring), That, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.

3 3672) making appropriations for disaster relief require-

4 ments for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and

5 for other purposes, the Clerk of the House of Representa-6 tives shall make the following corrections:

- 7 (1) In the heading for title III, strike "PROVI-8 SION" and insert "PROVISIONS".
- 9 (2) After section 301, insert the following new10 section:

"SEC. 302. (a) ACROSS-THE-BOARD RESCISSION.—
 There is hereby rescinded an amount equal to 1.83 percent
 of—

4 "(1) the budget authority provided for fiscal
5 year 2012 for any discretionary account in any fiscal
6 year 2012 appropriation Act (except the Department
7 of Defense Appropriations Act, 2012 and the Mili8 tary Construction and Veterans Affairs and Related
9 Agencies Appropriations Act, 2012); and

"(2) the budget authority provided in any advance appropriation for fiscal year 2012 for any discretionary account (other than for the Department
of Veterans Affairs) in any prior fiscal year appropriation Act.

15 "(b) PROPORTIONATE APPLICATION.—Any rescission
16 made by subsection (a) shall be applied proportionately—
17 "(1) to each discretionary account and each

18 item of budget authority described in such sub-19 section; and

"(2) within each such account and item, to each
program, project, and activity (with programs,
projects, and activities as delineated in the appropriation Act or accompanying reports for the relevant fiscal year covering such account or item, or
for accounts and items not included in appropriation

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Acts, as delineated in the most recently submitted
 President's budget).

3 "(c) EXCEPTIONS.—The rescission in subsection (a) 4 shall not apply to budget authority provided for fiscal year 5 2012 that is designated by the Congress as being for— 6 ((1))disaster relief pursuant to section 7 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-8 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985; or

9 "(2) Overseas Contingency Operations/Global
10 War on Terrorism pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)
11 of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Con12 trol Act of 1985.

"(d) SUBSEQUENT APPROPRIATIONS LAWS.—In the
case of any fiscal year 2012 appropriation law enacted
after the enactment of this section, any rescission required
by subsection (a) shall take effect immediately after the
enactment of such law.

18 "(e) OMB REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after 19 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the 20 Office of Management and Budget shall submit to the 21 Committees on Appropriations of the House of Represent-22 atives and the Senate a report specifying the account and 23 amount of each rescission made pursuant to subsection 24 (a).".
