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### Faleomavaega Holds Third Highest Minority Seat on House Resources Committee

American Samoa now holds the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest ranking minority seat on the House Committee on Resources which has responsibility for all matters regarding American Samoa.

For the past 14 years, I have been honored to serve as your Congressman and I am pleased that American Samoa now holds the 3rd highest ranking minority seat on the House Committee on Resources as a result of this seniority.

The House Committee on Resources is responsible for all matters regarding the insular areas, and this includes funding for American Samoa. For many years, there have been many attempts to cut American Samoa's funding but for the past 14 years Resources Committee members have been supportive of my efforts

to save American Samoa's funding.

To this day, American Samoa continues to be the only insular area that receives

### Faleomavaega Elected Top Minority Leader on House International Relations Subcommittee on Asia and Pacific

Faleomavaega has been selected by his party to serve as the highest minority member on the House Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific. The Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific has broad responsibility over U.S. foreign policy with Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Burma, Cambodia, China, Brunei, Cook Islands, Fiji, New Caledonia/French Polynesia, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kiribati, North Korea, South Korea, Micronesia, Mongolia, Nauru, Nepal, Niue, New Zealand, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Pakistan, Philippines, Russia (Far Eastern Policy), Samoa, Singapore, Solomon Islands, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Taiwan.

This region is critical to U.S. interests. Nearly 60-percent of the world's population lives in the Asia Pacific region, including the people of American Samoa. The world's six largest armed forces are also situated throughout the region. China's

In fact, all matters pertaining to American Samoa and the other insular areas are handled by the full Committee on Resources. Put another way, there is no Subcommittee on Insular Affairs and there is no Subcommittee on Territories. All matters specifically pertaining to American Samoa are handled by the full Committee on Resources. American Samoa now holds the 3rd most senior minority seat on this Committee.

The House Committee on Resources is made up of five Subcommittees. These Subcommittees are Fisheries, Energy, National Parks, Forests, and Water. In addition to my assignment on the full Committee on Resources, I will also be serving on the Subcommittee on Energy and the Subcommittee on Fisheries.

serve on the Fisheries Subcommittee. The Fisheries Subcommittee has responsibility for commercial fisheries, international fisheries agreements, aquaculture, seafood safety and fisheries promotion. The Fisheries Subcommittee also works with the National Sea Grant College program.

As a result of serving in this subcommittee last year, we were able to successfully establish a Sea Grant presence and an aquaculture project in American Samoa and it is still hoped that this year there will be new opportunities to expand our tilapia and giant clam projects.

As Congress begins its new session, I want to once more thank you for your prayers. These are historic times for American Samoa. Together we are making a difference and, as always, I will do my best to serve your needs.

military force is the largest followed by the United States, Russia, India, North Korea, and South Korea. The U.S. has fought three major wars in Asia in the last century, with enormous loss of life.

U.S. trade with the Asia Pacific region is also significant. U.S. businesses conducted more than \$500 billion in trade and have invested more than \$150 billion throughout the Asia Pacific region. Tuna, for example, is the third major fish commodity trade internationally and Thailand continues to be the largest exporter of canned tuna. The main tuna catching nations are also in Asia. Japan and Taiwan catch more tuna than any other nation in the world. Indonesia and South Korea are also important tuna fishing nations.

Given that American Samoa's economy is more than 80-percent dependent, either directly or indirectly, on the tuna business, I am pleased to represent the interests of American Samoa as the Ranking Member of the House International Relations Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific. It is a pleasure to also represent the interests of our men and women serving in the military. As I have said before, the threat of terrorism, nuclear build-up and military conflict in the Asia Pacific region is real. There is serious concern in the U.S. Congress about al-Qaeda cells and terrorist activities throughout the

region. There is also serious concern about North Korea's nuclear build-up.

We cannot know what the future holds and we do not know when or where our service men may be called to serve. What we do know is that these are critical times. These are critical times for American Samoa and these are critical times for the United States of America. These are the times when American Samoa must have a voice in the economic and military affairs of our region.

American Samoa now holds the number one Minority seat on the House International Relations Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific which is responsible for reviewing the problems of foreign policy and security threats from rogue regimes that have or could gain power to create or use weapons of mass destruction. This subcommittee also has broad responsibility for certain issues dealing with U.S. trade within the region and I am fully committed to doing everything through my service as Ranking Member to see that the interests of American Samoa are protected and represented.

## Faleomavaega Serves on House Committee on Small Business

In addition to my memberships in the House Committee on Resources and House Committee on International Relations, I also serve on the House Committee on Small Business.

In February of this year, the Democratic Steering Committee announced vacancies on the Committee on Small Business. Although the Democratic rules of the House usually only allow a member to serve on two Committees, special provisions were made for members wishing to serve on the Committee on Small Business. I want to thank the Democratic Steering Committee for honoring my request to serve.

The Committee on Small Business recognizes that small businesses are essential to the economic well-being of our communities. Small businesses foster economic opportunity and it is our duty as a Committee to facilitate the growth of small businesses and to minimize government intrusion.

This Congress, we have taken upon us the tasks of monitoring the effectiveness of the Small Business Administration and examining ways of improving access to medical care for small business owners and their employees. We will also be examining ways to expand export opportunities for small business. We have a full agenda before us this session, which is already well underway.

On March 5, 2003 Secretary Chao of the Department of Labor testifies before us regarding the challenge we have before us to make certain that small businesses are provided access to affordable and quality health care. This effort has wide-spread support from both Congress and the Bush Administration and I am pleased that I have the opportunity to sit on this Committee and help facilitate the creation of legislation that will benefit small business owners, including those in American Samoa.

The Department of Defense (DOD) has cancelled mail programs that allowed the general public to send mail addressed to "Any Service Member."

However, individuals may send Care Packages specifically addressed to their loved ones who are serving in the Iraq area or anywhere else overseas for that matter. Examples of suggested items for the Iraq area may include international calling cards, disposable cameras, toiletries, sunscreen, and letters or greeting cards. Some restrictions may apply. Check with the local post office for details on any restrictions.
