At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 3. PROTECTING THE PRIVACY OF INTERNET PASS-

2 WORDS AND THE CREATIVITY OF THE INTER-3 NET. 4 Nothing in this Act or the amendments made by this 5 Act shall be construed to— 6 (1) permit an employer, a prospective employer, 7 or the Federal Government to require the disclosure 8 of a confidential password for a social networking 9 website or a personal account of an employee or job 10 applicant without a court order; or 11 (2) permit the Federal Government to establish

12 (2) permit the Federal Government to establish 12 a mechanism to control United States citizens' ac-13 cess to and use of the Internet through the creation 14 of a national Internet firewall similar to the "Great

- 2 Director of the National Intelligence.

Page 12, line 25, strike the period and insert a semicolon.

Page 12, after line 25, insert the following:

"(G) the number of Americans who have— 3 "(i) been required by employers, pro-4 5 spective employers, or the Federal Government to release confidential passwords for 6 7 social networking websites; and 8 "(ii) had personal information re-9 leased to the Federal Government under 10 this section or obtained in connection with 11 a cybersecurity breach; and 12 "(H) the impact of the information that 13 has been released or obtained as referred to in 14 subparagraph (G) on privacy, electronic com-15 merce, Internet usage, and online content.
