- 1) H.Res.\_\_\_ Providing for the concurrence by the House in the Senate amendments to <u>H.R. 2838</u>, with an amendment (Rep. LoBiondo Transportation and Infrastructure)
- 2) <u>H.R. 6582</u> To allow for innovations and alternative technologies that meet or exceed desired energy efficiency goals, and to make technical corrections to existing Federal energy efficiency laws to allow American manufacturers to remain competitive, as amended (Rep. Aderholt – Energy and Commerce)
- **3)** <u>H.R. 6602</u> To make revisions in title 36, United States Code, as necessary to keep the title current and make technical corrections and improvements (Rep. Smith (TX) Judiciary)
- **4)** <u>H.R. 6605</u> To eliminate an unnecessary reporting requirement for an unfunded DNA Identification grant program (Rep. Conyers Judiciary)
- 5) <u>H.R. 6620</u> To eliminate certain limitations on the length of Secret Service Protection for former Presidents and for the children of former Presidents (Rep. Gowdy – Judiciary)
- 6) <u>H.R. 6223</u> To amend section 1059(e) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006 to clarify that a period of employment abroad by the Chief of Mission or United States Armed Forces as a translator, interpreter, or in an executive level security position is to be counted as a period of residence and physical presence in the United States for purposes of qualifying for naturalization if at least a portion of such period was spent in Iraq or Afghanistan, and for other purposes, as amended (Rep. Dent Judiciary)
- 7) <u>S. 3486</u> Patent Law Treaties Implementation Act of 2012 (Sen. Leahy Judiciary)
- 8) <u>S. 2367</u> 21st Century Language Act of 2012 (Rep. Conrad Judiciary)
