DAVE REICHERT IS SUPPORTING AMERICA'S VETERANS BY:

- Improving Employment Transition: Authored and passed legislation to improve the government's responsiveness to veterans' job needs after commissioning a study of problems veterans face in return to the civilian workforce from active duty.
- **Protecting Military Surviving Spouses:** Cosponsors legislation (H.R.178) that would eliminate the so-called "Widow's Tax," fixing an inequity in death benefits owed to military families.
- Helping Veteran-Owned Small Businesses: Passed an amendment providing assistance to disadvantaged small businesses, including those owned by service-disabled veterans.
- **Providing Pathways to Employment:** Lead Republican sponsor of legislation (H.R. 1896) to reauthorize the "Troops to COPS" program that funds the hiring and training of former Armed Forces personnel to serve as law enforcement officers.
- **Creating a Fair Retirement System:** Honors the courage and dedication of National Guard and Reserve members by supporting legislation (H.R. 181) that would allow members to receive credit towards early retirement by including any active duty service since September 11th, 2001.
