- Wednesday, August 1, 2012 – Subcommittee on Transportation Security hearing entitled “Breach of Trust: Addressing Misconduct Among TSA Screeners.”
- Wednesday, August 1, 2012 – Subcommittee on Oversight, Investigations, and Management markup of H.R. 5913, the “DHS Accountability Act of 2012.” Ordered reported to the Full Committee, favorably, amended, by voice vote.
- Friday, August 3 through Thursday, August 9, 2012 – CODEL to the United Mexican States, the Republic of Colombia, the Republic of Paraguay, the Federative Republic of Brazil, and the Argentine Republic to examine the presence of Iran and Hezbollah in South America, to examine the threat to the Southwest border from terrorists and drug cartels, and to acquire information about the terrorist pipeline from the Middle East into South America.
