GITMO Detainees on "No Fly List"

On Thursday, the House passed H.R. 2200, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Authorization bill by a vote of 397-25. The bill authorizes more than \$15.6 billion in appropriations for TSA activities and programs for FY 2010 and 2011, and includes provisions on a range of security issues. In particular, it triples the funding available for surface transportation security. Republicans offered a motion to amend the bill so that the "No Fly List" would include any individual who was a detainee held at Guantanamo Bay unless the President certifies to Congress that the detainee poses no threat to the United States, its citizens, or its allies. This motion was agreed to by the Majority.

Please see <u>VIDEO</u> of my speech on the House floor Thursday arguing that the government should require current and former GITMO detainees be *immediately* added to the Terror Watch List (No Fly List) so, if freed, they will not be able to board a commercial aircraft.

Federal Employees Paid Parental Leave Act

This week, the House passed H.R. 626, the Federal Employees Paid Paternal Leave Act. This bill would allow federal employees to substitute 4 weeks of *paid* leave for the existing guaranteed 12 weeks of *unpaid* leave for the birth or adoption of a child. It is estimated that this bill will cost \$938 million over five years. I opposed this legislation because I am concerned that with the current state of the economy, now is not the best time to enact such a large bill at taxpayer expense, especially when private sector workers are concerned for their jobs, let alone rarely receive such generous leave allotments.

War Supplemental Cluttered with IMF Funding

Next week, the House will consider the Conference Report on the War Supplemental Spending bill. In the Senate version, \$108 billion in funding for the International Monetary Fund (IMF) was included. This is one aspect of the Supplemental that I am concerned about. I feel this IMF funding has no place in a bill intended to aid our troops in combat overseas. Further, given our economic crisis I believe we must better scrutinize every dollar we send overseas to foreign countries.

DTV Transition

The nation will be completing the transition to digital television on **June 12, 2009**. The transition will only affect older antenna TVs that are not hooked up to cable, satellite or other pay television service. If you do not subscribe to pay television service, the TV Converter Box Coupon Program offer two \$40 coupons per a household to assist with purchasing eligible converters. Congress recently passed legislation to allow consumers with expired coupons to request replacements.
