Dear President Bush, Speaker Pelosi, Majority Leader Hoyer, Minority Leader Boehner, Senate Majority Leader Reid, Senate Minority Leader McConnell,

Last year, disputes between the White House and new Majority Leadership in Congress on spending caused the delay of funding vital to our nation's veterans. Although legislation eventually passed providing a much needed increase in veterans funding, it came far too late costing our veterans \$18.5 million a day from October 1st through December 26th of 2007. We call upon your leadership to see that veterans funding be removed from the political infighting and gamesmanship that will inevitably occur over the Fiscal Year 2009 budget by passing veterans funding before September 30, 2008.

Veterans funding is not and should not be a partisan issue. Therefore, we should work together to make it clear that Congress takes its obligation to our nation's veterans seriously. Since 9/11 we have called on our soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines to keep us safe from terror. Their sacrifices now and in conflicts past are immeasurable; however, when they call upon us to uphold our promises to them as veterans, the Majority Leadership continues to fall short. This summer, we can join together and pass an appropriations bill that will honor our veterans' commitments and show our appreciation for their service.

If past tragedies such as the shock of inadequate care at Walter Reed Army Medical Center are to be avoided in the future, we must pass veterans funding on time. We must also never forget the sacrifices our veterans have made for us. As members of Congress, we have a solemn obligation to fulfill our promises to them. We ask you to look past the heightened partisanship of our times and unite on this issue by making it a first priority to bring a stand-alone veterans appropriations bill through regular order so we may pass Military Construction and Veterans' Affairs Appropriations bill no later than September 30, 2008.

We stand ready to assist you in this matter.
