One-Year Highlights

Fiscally Conservative & Independent

- **Balanced Budget Amendment:** Rep. Hochul was the only New York Democrat and 1 of only 24 Democrats nationwide to <u>vote for the Balanced Budget Amendment</u> to manage our nation's finances in the same way Western New York families do every day.
- **Cut Spending:** Rep. Hochul has voted to cut over \$2.4 trillion from the federal budget.
- **Eliminating Red Tape:** Rep. Hochul <u>worked with local farmers</u> to eliminate burdensome regulations on small businesses and family farmers like restrictions on farm dust and winter manure.
- Energy Independence: Rep. Hochul helped pass legislation approving the Keystone XL pipeline.

Economic Investment & Innovation

- **School-To-Work:** Rep. Hochul introduced legislation to partner educational institutions with local businesses to ensure we are training a skilled workforce that will stay here in Western New York.

- Access to Farm Labor: Rep. Hochul introduced bipartisan legislation to <u>improve the H-2A visa</u> program so that local farmers can obtain the temporary labor they need to strengthen New York's dairy industry, and helped create a process for farmers to submit forms online and reduce paperwork.
- **Supporting Local Businesses:** Rep. Hochul partnered with the <u>Small Business Administration</u> to help local businesses like Save-A-Lot in the Village of Holley secure loans to encourage economic growth.

Protecting our Seniors

- **Protecting Medicare:** Rep. Hochul led the fight against the <u>Ryan Budget</u>, which would end Medicare as we know it while giving tax breaks to millionaires and billionaires.
- **Preventing Rationing of Care:** Rep. Hochul crossed party lines in a vote to repeal the <u>Independent Payment Advisory Board</u> (IPAB). Created by the Affordable Care Act, IPAB creates a panel of 15 unelected bureaucrats designed to cut Medicare, which could result in the rationing of health care services.

- **Fighting for the Air Base:** Rep. Hochul successfully authored an amendment that would prevent the immediate closing of the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station.
- **Promoting Veterans Health Care:** Rep. Hochul introduced <u>tele-health legislation</u> to cut the travel time and costs while ensuring quality health care services for veterans.
