## MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 2 OFFERED BY M\_\_.

M\_. \_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2 to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Ways and Means, and Education and the Workforce with instructions to report the same to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add at the end the following new section:

1	SEC. 3. HEALTH CARE REPEAL SHALL NOT TAKE EFFECT
2	UNLESS A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF U.S.
3	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND A MAJOR-
4	ITY OF U.S. SENATORS WAIVE FEHBP BENE-
5	FITS.
6	Section 2 (including the repeal of the Patient Protec-
7	tion and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148)) shall
8	not take effect unless and until the Director of the Office
9	of Personnel Management certifies to the Congress that
10	a majority of the Members of the House of Representa-
11	tives and a majority of Members of the Senate have, as
12	of the date that is 30 days after the date of initial passage
13	of this Act in the respective House, voluntarily and perma-
14	nently withdrawn from any participation, and waived all

- 1 rights to participate, as such a Member in the federally
- 2 funded Federal employees health benefits program
- 3 (FEHBP) under chapter 89 of title 5, United States
- 4 Code, effective with the first month after the date of exe-
- 5 cution of such a withdrawal and waiver.
