

## MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

\_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 4310 to the Committee on Armed Services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendments:

Strike section 343.

At the end of subtitle C of title X, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1023. REPAIRING U.S. SHIPS IN AMERICAN PORTS TO**  
2 **CREATE JOBS.**

3 Section 7310 of title 10, United States Code, is  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 **“§ 7310 Overhaul, repair, etc. of vessels in foreign**  
6 **shipyards: restrictions**

7 “(a) DOMESTIC SHIPYARDS.—Except as provided in  
8 subsection (b), each naval vessel and each United States-  
9 flagged vessel that is providing services to the Federal  
10 Government may not be overhauled, repaired, or main-  
11 tained in a shipyard outside the United States or Guam,  
12 other than in the case of voyage repairs.

13 “(b) WAIVER.—The Secretary of Defense may waive  
14 the requirement in subsection (a) if the Secretary—

1           “(1) determines that such waiver—  
2                   “(A) is necessary for purposes of national  
3           security; or  
4                   “(B) is in response to urgent repair; and  
5           “(2) notifies the congressional defense commit-  
6           tees of such waiver by not later than two days after  
7           issuing such waiver.”.
