## MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

M . moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 514, to the Committee on the Judiciary with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment: At the end of section 1, add the following new subsection: 1 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTITUTION.— 2 (1) Investigations must comply with con-3 STITUTION.—Each investigation of a United States 4 citizen conducted under an extended authority shall 5 be conducted in a manner that complies with the Constitution of the United States, including the first 6 7 through tenth amendments to the Constitution of the United States (commonly known as the "Bill of 8 9 Rights"). 10 (2) Expedited review of violations.—In 11 any civil proceeding before a Federal court that in-12 volves an alleged violation of paragraph (1), such 13 court shall expedite such proceeding.

1	(3) Extended authority defined.—In this
2	subsection, the term "extended authority" means
3	any authority available under—
4	(A) an amendment to section $105(c)(2)$ ,
5	501, or 502 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveil-
6	lance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1805(c)(2), 1861,
7	1862) that took effect after October 25, 2001;
8	or
9	(B) section $101(b)(1)(C)$ of such Act, as
10	amended by section 6001(a) of the Intelligence
11	Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act (Public
12	Law 108-458; 118 Stat. 3742).
