We are writing in response to your letter of February 25, 2011, which requests information and/or documents from PHH Mortgage Corporation ("PHH") pertaining to five topics. The requests and our responses are as follows:

1. Copies of all internal investigations and audits conducted by or on behalf of your organization relating to foreclosure policies, procedure, or practices;

Response: PHH respectfully objects to providing copies of these investigations, which have been conducted by and/or for our attorneys. These documents are protected by the attorney/client privilege, and the work product immunity.

2. Copies of all documents and communications with customers, within your organization, and with individuals or entities outside your organization relating to instances in which your organization determined that foreclosures were not properly executed;

Response: PHH interprets this request as pertaining to affidavits submitted in support of foreclosures. These documents are maintained by PHH's foreclosure attorneys. PHH is informed by its foreclosure counsel in Illinois and Florida, that some affidavits were not properly completed, and that they have taken immediate steps to rectify the specific issue(s) relating to those particular documents.

3. Copies of all documents and communications with customers, within your organization, and with individuals or entities outside your organization relating to instances in which your organization determined that improper fees were charged to homeowners in excess of \$5,000 per household;
