Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (OEM)

<u>OEM</u> is responsible for developing and maintaining the State's ability to effectively respond to threats and coordinates State emergency operations, including disaster assistance. OEM has published a list of <u>resources and helpful links</u> for disaster victims, as well as <u>publications and forms</u> that may be helpful in recovery and preparing for future tornadoes.

Multi-Agency Resource Center

The Eastern Oklahoma Red Cross has set up a Multi-Agency Resource Center (MARC) at the Quapaw Nation Cultural Center building to provide long-term recovery services to tornado victims. Over ten relief agencies will be represented at the MARC, including:
