## 1 SEC. 2. EXEMPT SUPPLIES.

2 Section 325(u) of the Energy Policy and Conserva3 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 6295(u)) is amended by adding at
4 the end the following:

5 "(5) EXEMPT SUPPLIES.— 6 "(A) FEBRUARY 10, 2014, RULE.— 7 "(i) IN GENERAL.—An external power 8 supply shall not be subject to the final rule 9 entitled 'Energy Conservation Program: 10 Energy Conservation Standards for Exter-11 nal Power Supplies', published at 79 Fed. 12 Reg. 7845 (February 10, 2014), if the ex-13 ternal power supply— "(I) is manufactured during the 14 15 period beginning on February 10, 16 2016, and ending on February 10, 2020;17 18 "(II) is marked in accordance 19 with the External Power Supply 20 International Efficiency Marking Pro-21 tocol, as in effect on February 10, 22 2016: "(III) meets, where applicable, 23 24 the standards under paragraph 25 (3)(A), and has been certified to the 26 Secretary as meeting International
