

The American Health Care Reform Act

- FULLY REPEALS THE PRESIDENT'S HEALTH CARE LAW Ends billions in taxes, eliminates thousands of pages of unworkable mandates and regulations that are driving up the cost of health care and forcing millions of Americans to lose access to their health plans, and gets federal bureaucrats, like IRS agents, out of our health care decisions.
- ♣ SPURS COMPETITION TO LOWER HEALTH COSTS Increases competition by allowing Americans to purchase health insurance across state lines, and creates association health plans so small businesses can pool together to get the same buying power as large corporations.
- TAX REFORM THAT ALLOWS FAMILIES TO DEDUCT HEALTH CARE COSTS

Levels the playing field for families and individuals by creating a standard deduction for any taxpayer to purchase health care with the same tax benefits that companies enjoy.

- → COMMON-SENSE MEDICAL MALPRACTICE REFORM Addresses the medical liability crisis, which has played a significant role in escalating health care costs, by capping non-economic damages and limiting attorneys' fees, while maintaining patients' rights to economic damages.
- → EXPANDS ACCESS TO HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNTS (HSAs)

Increases the amount of pre-tax dollars individuals can deposit into portable savings accounts to be used for health care expenses.

* SAFEGUARDS INDIVIDUALS WITH PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS

Bolsters state-based high-risk pools and extends existing HIPAA guaranteed availability protections, improving insurance portability protections for Americans with pre-existing conditions.

➡ PROTECTS THE UNBORN Incorporates widely-supported pro-life provisions, ensuring that no federal dollars may be used to provide abortions.
