- Three letters of recommendation (one must be an academic reference)
- Five essay questions as listed below

1. Who, in your mind, is the most important figure in American history and why? (1/2 page)
2. What has been your biggest accomplishment in life? (1/2 page)
3. What do you consider to be your weakest point? (1/2 page)
4. Where do you see yourself in ten years? (1/2 page)
5. Why do you want to attend a military academy? (1 page)
