

H.R. 5016 – The Financial Services and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

House Adopted Amendments

Sessions (R-TX) – The amendment cuts \$1.75 million from the Treasury Department’s Offices-Salaries and Expenses account, and transfers the savings to the Spending Reduction Account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Posey (R-FL) – The amendment adds \$1 million to the Office of the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration, offset by a reduction to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Enforcement account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Lynch (D-MA) – The amendment increases funding for the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network account by \$3.4 million, offset by a reduction to the General Services Administration Rent account and the Basic Repair and Alterations account of \$1.7 million each. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jackson Lee (D-TX) – The amendment increases funding for the Treasury Department’s Community Development Financial Institution account by \$500,000, offset by a \$1 million reduction in the IRS Taxpayer Service account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Roskam (R-IL) – The amendment increases the IRS Taxpayer Service account by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the IRS Enforcement account. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 338-80.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment directs an additional \$2.8 million within the IRS Taxpayer Service account to the Tax Counseling for the Elderly program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Blackburn (R-TN) – The amendment increases funding for the Consumer Product Safety Commission by \$1 million, offset by a \$2 million reduction in the IRS Enforcement account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment cuts \$353 million from the IRS Enforcement account, and transfers the funds to the Spending Reduction Account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Huizenga (R-MI) – The amendment cuts the IRS Enforcement account by \$788 million, and transfers the funds to the Spending Reduction Account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Camp (R-MI) – The amendment cuts \$2 million from the IRS Operations Support account, and transfers the funding to the Spending Reduction Account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment increases funding for the Courts of Appeals, District Courts, and the Other Judicial Services Salaries and Expenses account by \$42 million, offset by a reduction in the GSA Federal Buildings Fund Rent account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment increases funding for the Small Business Administration (SBA) Entrepreneurial Development Programs account by \$3.8 million, offset by a reduction in the SBA Salaries and Expenses account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Frelinghuysen (R-NJ) – The amendment reduces National Security and Homeland Security Council funding by \$4.2 million. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

DeLauro (D-CT) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used to award contracts to corporations incorporated or chartered in Bermuda or the Cayman Islands that were previously incorporated in the United States. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Bachus (R-AL) – The amendment prohibits funding to reinstall the “Red Mountain” sculpture at the Hugo Black courthouse in Birmingham, AL. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Schakowsky (R-IL) – The amendment prohibits funding to award contracts to contractors who have violated certain wage requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Meehan (R-PA) – The amendment prohibits funding to renovate or rebuild the White House bowling alley. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to award a contract to a company currently indicted or previously convicted of certain crimes, or that has outstanding delinquent taxes of more than \$3,000 within a three-year period of the contract. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding to award bonuses to members of the IRS senior executive service. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 282-138-1.**

Walberg (R-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding to be used in contravention of the Federal Records Act. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Farenthold (R-TX) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used to pay the salary of any federal employee who has been held in contempt of Congress. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Heck (D-WA) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used to penalize a financial institution for providing services to marijuana-related business that engages in activities permissible under state or local laws. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 231-192.**

Price (R-GA) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used by the IRS to release confidential taxpayer information in contravention of section 6103 of the Internal Revenue Code. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

DeSantis (R-FL) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used by the IRS to create machine readable materials that are not subject to certain safeguards. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 351-71.**

DeSantis (R-FL) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used by the IRS on conferences. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 264-157.**

Blackburn (R-TN) – The amendment prohibits funds from being used from the TARP Hardest Hit Fund to fulfill unfunded state and local pension bailouts. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 239-183.**

Blackburn (R-TN) – The amendment prohibits funding for the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to implement any regulation preempting state law regarding municipal broadband internet access. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 223-200.**

Blackburn (R-TN) – The amendment prohibits funds for the Consumer Product Safety Commission to finalize, implement, or enforce the proposed “voluntary recall” rule. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 229-194.**

Engel (D-NY) – The amendment prohibits funding to lease or purchase new light-duty vehicles, for any executive fleet, or for an agency's fleet inventory, except in accordance a Presidential Memorandum-Federal Fleet Performance. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Garrett (R-NJ) – The amendment prohibits funding to designate a nonbank financial company as "too big to fail", as a "systemically important financial institution", or that any such company could pose a threat to the financial stability of the U.S. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Massie (R-KY) – The amendment prohibits funding for the District of Columbia to enforce various local laws related to firearms. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 241-181.**

Lankford (R-OK) – The amendment prohibits funding for the SEC to promulgate rules related to fiduciary standards for investment advisors, brokers, or dealers. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
