One of these women is Joe Perry from Aerosmith.



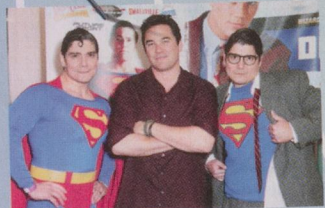
Spoiler alert! New *Breaking Bad* poster verifies that Walt will once again be wearing shoes that look suspiciously like Clarks Wallbees.

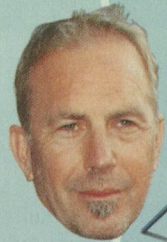
Russell Brand forgot he was hosting the MTV Movie Awards and not the Friars Club roast of Michael Fassbender's penis.

New Green Lantern is gay. What gave it away? The huge ring? Or the flames coming off him?

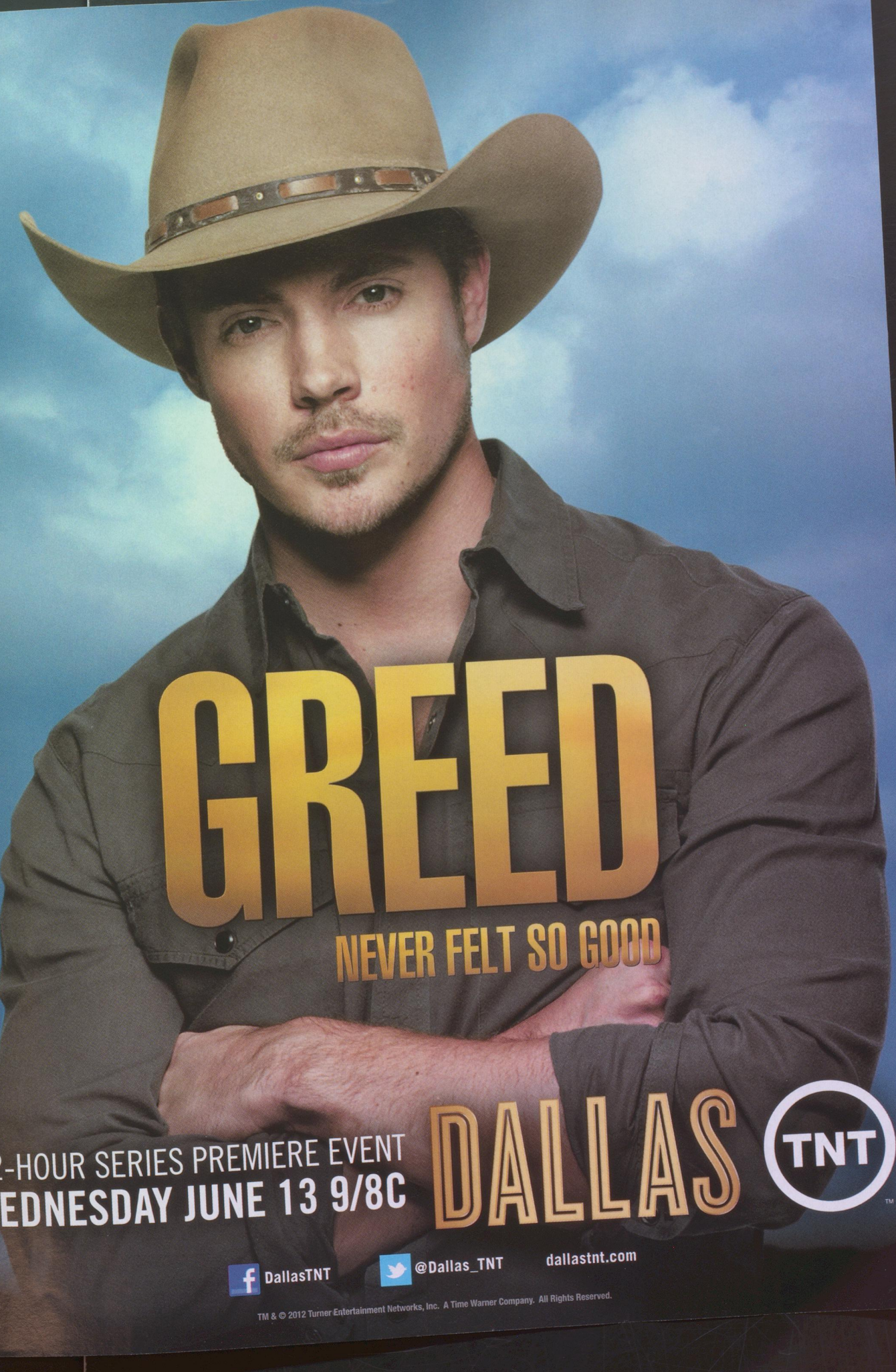

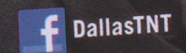
