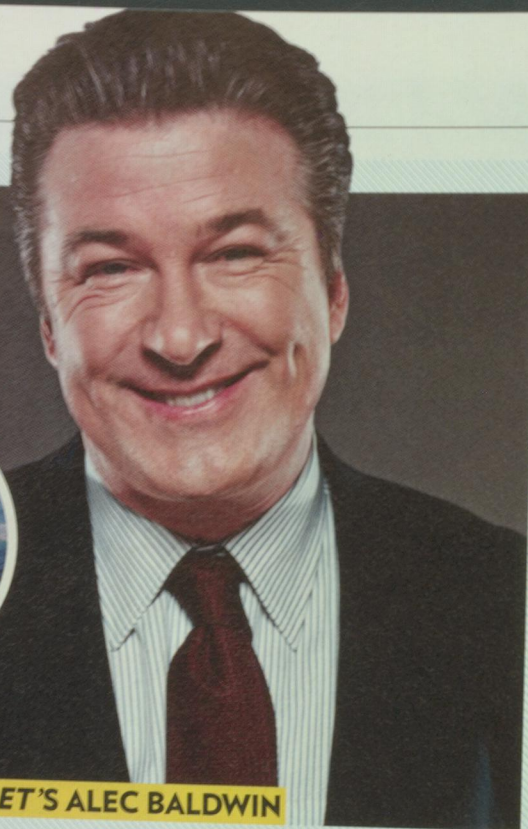

**WHY DO YOU THINK YOU'RE SO IN DEMAND AS A NARRATOR?**

When you're on TV, people hear your voice every week and get a sense of familiarity. I have to start charging as much for voice-overs as for acting!

They always take things from my own life to make fun of me. That I'm running for mayor. My character dates women 20 years younger than him. They use whatever I do to skewer me on the show, but I don't care.

I do it at auctions all the time. One time we raised \$25,000. And any time a friend has a dreadful outgoing message, I force them to let me change it.

If at first you don't succeed: Mireille Enos returns to the case.

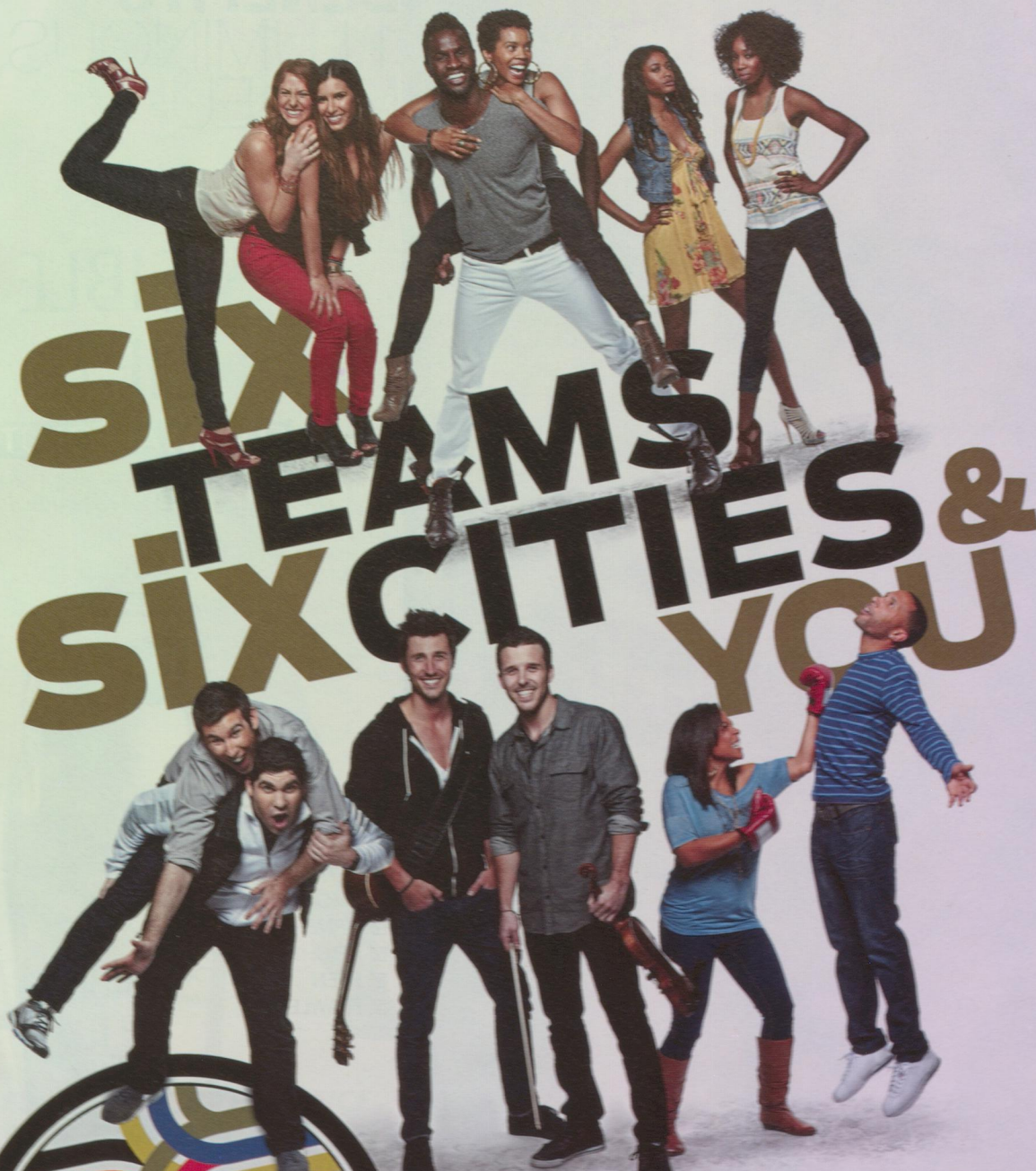
## Magic City

Judged as real estate, *Magic City* is triple-mint. Set in a deluxe Miami hotel called the Miramar Playa in the late '50s, *City* has marble lobbies, beautiful pools, skin-kissing sunlight. It makes *Mad Men* look like a dormitory suite. The story is promising; Jeffrey Dean Morgan plays hotel owner Ike Evans. His main headache: He's been bankrolled by mobster Ben "the Butcher" Diamond (Danny Huston). The first three episodes roll out more slowly than necessary, but there's a great, delirious scene of partiers on a yacht shooting at sharks. Check it out.
