



## BEYONCÉ & JAY-Z INSIDE THEIR TRIP to CUBA

*Feliz Aniversario!* **Beyoncé**, 31, and **Jay-Z**, 43, feted their fifth anniversary with a trip to Havana accompanied by their moms, Tina Knowles and Gloria Carter—and some controversy. During their brief stay, the group hit up the iconic La Guarida restaurant on April 3 for a two-hour dinner where “they were happy, relaxed and having fun,” says an observer. But their trip didn’t please everyone. Due to a U.S. embargo with the communist country, many Americans are prohibited from traveling there without approval from the Treasury department’s Office of Foreign Assets Control, and two U.S. Representatives sent a letter calling for more info about the stars’ getaway. While reps for the singers didn’t respond to requests for comment, a source familiar with the trip told Reuters the two were “fully licensed.”

Beyoncé was “very beautiful, with no makeup on,” an observer says of the star (in Havana with Jay-Z on their April 4 anniversary).
