

**Summary of H.R. 1025**  
**Recognize the service in the reserve components of certain persons by honoring them with status as veterans under law**

**Title:** To amend title 38, United States Code, to recognize the service in the reserve components of certain persons by honoring them with status as veterans under law

**Mr. Walz** introduced this legislation on March 10, 2011.

**H.R. 1025 would:**

- Provide that any person who is entitled under chapter 1223 of title 10 to retired pay for non-regular service or, but for age, would be entitled under such chapter to retired pay for non-regular service shall be honored as a veteran but shall not be entitled to any benefit by reason of this section.

**Effective Date:** Date of enactment.

**Legislative History:**

- Jul. 22, 2011: Ordered reported by the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- Sept. 8, 2011: Full Committee Markup – ordered reported to the House.
- Oct. 5, 2011: Reported by the Committee, H. Rept. 112-233.
- Oct. 11, 2011: House agreed to suspend the rules and pass the bill by voice vote.
