Summary of H.R. 1025

Recognize the service in the reserve components of certain persons by honoring them with status as veterans under law

Title: To amend title 38, United States Code, to recognize the service in the reserve components of certain persons by honoring them with status as veterans under law

Mr. Walz introduced this legislation on March 10, 2011.

H.R. 1025 would:

• Provide that any person who is entitled under chapter 1223 of title 10 to retired pay for non-regular service or, but for age, would be entitled under such chapter to retired pay for non-regular service shall be honored as a veteran but shall not be entitled to any benefit by reason of this section.
