

U.S. Military Service Academy Congressional Nomination Information Sheet

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of July 1 of the year of admission to the academy:

- Between 17 and 22 years of age
- Possess U.S. citizenship
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and with no legal obligation to support children or other dependants
- Reside in the 53rd Congressional District of California

Selection Criteria

Nominations from Congresswoman Davis are based on a "whole person" evaluation. Applicants are considered for a nomination at four levels:

- The FIRST consideration is academics. Each individual's grade point average, SAT/ACT scores, class ranking and willingness to embrace academic challenges will be considered.
- The SECOND consideration is leadership experience and potential command ability. This will be based on the resume of activities submitted in the application packet and would include involvement in sports, school, civic and personal/social activities.
- The THIRD consideration is the motivation and desire of the applicants to attend a service academy. This will be based on both the essay submitted and the interview before the Academy Nominee Selection Board.
- The FOURTH consideration is comparative in nature, appraising each applicant's attributes against all who are applying.

Applications to the Academies

Application **MUST** also be made to the Director of Admissions of the Academy or Academies of your choice, in addition to the nomination application to Congresswoman Davis.

Merchant Marine Academy

For the Merchant Marine Academy, a Member of Congress may nominate as with the other academies, however, there is no dedicated position available. Each nominee selected must compete statewide for the vacancies, and the Merchant Marine Academy makes the selection.

U.S. Coast Guard Academies

A Congressional nomination is not required for the Coast Guard Academy, as they manage their own selection process. Any individual interested in applying must contact the Academy directly. You may submit an application online at http://www.cga.edu.

Final Admission to Academies

Selected nominees will be announced in January 2015. The slate of nominees chosen by Congresswoman Davis will then be forwarded to the academies indicated. The selection of the appointee to each academy is ultimately decided by the academy to which you have applied.

Academy Nominee Selection Board

Upon receiving the properly completed packet, potential nominees will then be interviewed and evaluated by Congresswoman Davis' Academy Nominee Selection Board. This board is made up of individuals with unique knowledge of the requirements of the academies. They will look closely at all aspects of those

individuals who are being considered. This evaluation is based on the above "Selection Criteria" and the in-person interview. The board is scheduled to consider applicants in November 2014. Those who qualify for nomination will be ranked in order of merit, with the most highly qualified receiving nominations as availability at each academy allows. This slate of nominees will number ten individuals per opening available. There maybe more qualified applicants than available openings, and in such a case the first ten will be submitted, with the other applicants being placed on a stand-by list.

Announcement of Nominees

The announcement of nominees will likely occur during the month of December 2014. The nominations will then be forwarded to the appropriate academies where another evaluation will be performed by the Academy.

Depending on how well you have competed amongst this year's pool of candidates, you can be nominated to multiple academies. It is also possible to win multiple appointments.

Admission to Academies

SELECTION OF THE APPOINTEE TO EACH ACADEMY IS ULTIMATLY DECIDED UPON BY THE ACADEMY TO WHICH YOU HAVE APPLIED. Nomination by Congresswoman Davis does not automatically result in selection by the Military Service Academies.

All applicants must directly contact the academies they are interested in attending to open an admissions file. If you do not apply directly to the academies, you cannot be accepted there. Academies will begin to notify applicants of their admissions status in February, and all offers of appointment are generally sent out by May.
