Justice Elena Kagan: The Senate voted, 63-37, to confirm Solicitor General Elena Kagan, 50, as the 112th justice of the Supreme Court. All Democrats except Sen. Ben Nelson of Nebraska, both independent senators and five of the 41 GOP senators supported her. A yes vote was to confirm Kagan.	Y	Y
Aid to Schools, States: Senators approved, 61-39, a deficit-neutral, \$26 billion package of aid for school districts and state budgets. A yes vote was to send the House a bill (HR 1586) providing \$10 billion to save more than 100,000 teaching jobs and \$16 billion for paying Medicaid claims.	Y	Y

KEY VOTES AHEAD

The House will vote Tuesday on appropriating \$26 billion for averting teacher layoffs and helping states pay Medicaid claims. The House then will join the Senate in recess until Sept. 13.
