## FIGHTING TO IMPROVE MEDICARE AND SOCIAL SECURITY

Congressman Lipinski is cosponsoring bills that would:

- Provide full Social Security benefits for retired public servants, such as teachers, firefighters, and police officers.
- Lower Medicare drug costs for seniors by allowing the government to negotiate better prices.
- Allow more seniors to qualify for extra help paying for prescription drugs.

## DEFENDING SENIORS' RETIREMENT SAVINGS

Over the past year, many seniors have seen the value of their hard-earned retirement savings decline due to the recession that was sparked by reckless behavior on Wall Street. Congressman Lipinski voted against the Bailout all three times it came before the House for a vote, and believes we must enact tougher regulations to prevent Wall Street gamblers from doing further harm to the economy. We must protect seniors' savings so they can enjoy their retirement.
