

CCSD Magnet/Career and Technical Academies (CTA) offer learning opportunities related to various themes for interested students. Students from across the District may apply to a Magnet/CTA, regardless of the region in which they reside. The purposes of Magnet/CTAs are to improve student achievement, promote diversity, and create an awareness of career opportunities relative to the fields of study in which students may be interested.

Magnet/CTAs are available for grades 1-12. Secondary schools include both middle and high school levels. Any student in grades K-11 who will be living within the boundaries of CCSD may apply for a Magnet/CTA. There are currently six elementary schools, six middle schools, and 13 high schools designated as Magnet/CTAs. At the $1^{\rm st}$, $6^{\rm th}$, and $9^{\rm th}$ grade levels, there are a set number of seats available. At other grade levels, available seats will depend on how many students have exited the program.

- There are approximately 16,000 applicants annually for 7,000 seats.
 Currently, there are 21,000 students in Magnet/Career and Technical Academies.
- CCSD has seven stand-alone Career and Technical Academies. These stateof-the-art institutions have over 65 programs among them, including:
 - Agriculture and National Resources
 - Architecture and Construction
 - Arts, Audio-Video Technology, and Communications
 - Business, Finance, Marketing, Sales, and Service
 - Education and Human Resources
 - Hospitality and Tourism
 - Information Technology
 - Law, Public Safety, and Leadership
 - Medical and Health Science
 - Science Technology, Engineering, and Math
 - Transportation/Automotive
