II • Application Package Checklist

The following items are required for a nomination:

Service Academy

1. A completed application for nomination with the respective service academy. This is achieved by contacting the respective service academy via mail, website, email or a phone call.

- 1. A completed congressional application. The application includes:
 - a. Personal Information
 - b. Personal Commentary, which includes a 500-word essay describing yourself, your goals and the reasons you would like to attend an academy.
 - c. Two teacher recommendations: Use the recommendation forms included in the application. Teachers should complete the forms, seal them in envelopes, and return the forms to the student. The forms must arrive with the application package in sealed envelopes. Separate letters of recommendation are <u>NOT</u> required and will not be considered if received.
 - d. Interview Request form
- Official high school transcripts. The official transcripts must arrive with the application package in a sealed envelope. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.
