

2014 Congressional Art Competition Guidelines

The competition is open to all high school students (grades 9-12) who are legal residents of the 35th Congressional District of California. Please confirm that you are a resident of the 35th District before submitting your entry. If you do not reside in the 35th District, please contact the Member of Congress who represents your district in which you reside. To confirm your Congressional District, please visit: <u>http://house.gov</u>.

All artwork, including completed Student Entry and Release Form must be received on or before **April 4, 2014**. Artwork may be delivered to the District Office located at 4959 Palo Verde Street., Suite II0B, Montclair, CA 91763 between the hours of 9 am to 5 pm.

All artwork must be framed and conform to the following restrictions:

UNFRAMED ARTWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

4 All artwork must be finished, dry, and ready-to-hang.

- Frames must be made of wood and metal. No plastic "snap on" frames or metal frames that can easily come apart are to be used.
- All framed art or art on a stretched canvas must include necessary hooks, wires, and/or other hardware for hanging.
- Two sturdy eye hooks or an equivalent must be attached at the top right and left sides of the back of the frame.
- Do not put wire between hooks for hanging.
- 0 Do not attach labels, ribbons, etc. to the front of the piece.
- Please indicate which side is up by marking arrows pointing towards the top on the back of the piece.
- **4** Artwork must be two dimensional.
- Each piece can be <u>no larger</u> than 28"x28"x4" (28 inches high, 28 inches wide, and 4 inches deep) <u>including the frame</u>.
- **4** Artwork cannot weigh more than 15 lbs. <u>when framed.</u>
- Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution and <u>may not</u> violate any U.S. copyright laws.



- Any entry that has been copied from an existing photo (not the student's own), painting, graphic, advertisement or any other work produced by another person is a violation of the competition rules and <u>will not</u> be accepted.
- 4 Work entered must be in the original medium (that is, not a scanned reproduction)
- Please attach a label to the back of your artwork with your name, address, contact information, school, and artwork title.

Artwork accepted mediums are as follows:

- 4 Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.
- Drawings: colored pencil, pencil, ink, marker, pastels, charcoal (It is recommended that charcoal and pastel drawings be fixed.)
- Collage: must be two dimensional
- 븆 Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
- Hixed Media; use of more than two mediums such as pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.
- **↓** Computer generated art
- ♣ Photographs

Sculptures, masks, etc., are not permitted.

The Ist Place entry will hang in the United States Capitol for an entire year and cannot be returned earlier. The 2nd Place entry will hang in Congresswoman Negrete McLeod's Capitol Office and the 3rd Place entry will hang in Congresswoman Negrete McLeod's Montclair District Office.

Students should only submit artwork they will not need for other purpose.

The winning entries will be announced at a reception to be held on Wednesday, April 23, 2014 from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm at the Montclair Senior Center located at 5111 Benito Street, Montclair, CA 91763.

The reception will begin at 6:00 pm with the presentation of awards beginning at 6:30 pm.

Upon conclusion of reception, submitted art work will be released back to the participating student with the exception of the winning entries.
