Summary of Progress of Specific Studies and Investigations

July 2009

I. Full Committee Progress

July 8th, the committee met to receive a secret brief from the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy on issues related to the drawdown in Iraq.

July 15th, the committee met to receive testimony on Addressing a New Generation of Threats from Weapons of Mass Destruction: Department of Energy Nonproliferation Programs and the Department of Defense Cooperative Threat Reduction Program.

July 15th, the committee met to receive a top secret/SCI brief from the National Counter Proliferation Center, the National Counter Terrorism Center, the CIA Weapons, Intelligence, Nonproliferation and Arms Control Center, and DOE's Office of Intelligence.

July 16th, the committee met to receive testimony on Prosecuting Law of War Violations: Reforming the Military Commissions Act of 2006.

July 21st, the committee met to mark up H. Res. 602 – Requesting that the President and directing that the Secretary of Defense transmit to the House of Representatives all information in their possession relating to specific communications regarding detainees and foreign persons suspected of terrorism.

July 22nd, the committee met to receive a secret brief from the Department of Defense on issues related to the drawdown in Iraq.

July 24th, the committee met to receive testimony on reforming the Military Commissions Act of 2006 and detainee policy.

July 30th, the committee met to receive testimony on the U.S. security relationship with Russia and its impact on transatlantic security.

II. Subcommittee Progress

Air and Land Forces Subcommittee

July 9th, the subcommittee met jointly with the Subcommittee on Seapower and Expeditionary Forces and the Readiness Subcommittee to receive testimony on the status of Army and Marine Corps equipment reset requirements. The hearing stands in recess and will continue September 22.

July 9th, the subcommittee met to in a joint session with the Air and Land Forces Subcommittee and the Seapower and Expeditionary Forces Subcommittee to receive testimony on Army and Marine Corps Reset Requirements. The hearing stands in recess and will continue September 22.

July 23rd, the subcommittee met to receive testimony on the Proposed Reconfiguration of the National Defense Stockpile.

Terrorism, Unconventional Threats and Capabilities Subcommittee

July 21st, the subcommittee met to receive a classified briefing on the global disposition of Special Operations Command.

July 23rd, the subcommittee met to receive a classified briefing on Department of Defense efforts to curb drug cartel activity.

July 28th, the subcommittee met to receive testimony on the Consequence Management for Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear or High-yield Explosive Attacks.

Personnel Subcommittee

July 22nd, the subcommittee met to receive testimony on the Oversight of Family Support Programs.

July 29th, the subcommittee met to receive testimony on “Psychological Stress in the Military: What Steps are Leaders Taking?”

Strategic Forces Subcommittee

July 21st, the subcommittee met to receive a classified briefing on the space projection program.

July 29th, the subcommittee met to receive a classified briefing on Missile Defense Agency (MDA) special programs.

Seapower and Expeditionary Forces Subcommittee
