1	SEC. 2. EBENEZER D. BASSETT COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE
2	STAMP.
3	(a) ISSUANCE.—The Postmaster General shall issue
4	a commemorative postage stamp in honor of Ebenezer D.
5	Bassett.
6	(b) REQUIREMENTS.—Such stamp shall—
7	(1) be issued in the denomination used for first
8	class mail up to one ounce in weight;
9	(2) bear such designs as the Postmaster Gen-
10	eral shall determine; and
11	(3) be placed on sale as soon as practicable
12	after the date of the enactment of this section and
13	shall be sold for such period thereafter as the Post-
14	master General shall determine.
