### **Unemployment Insurance**

<b>Administrator</b>	Arizona's Department of Economic Security
<b>Description</b>	The Arizona Department of Economic Security provides temporary unemployment insurance benefits as provided by state law to eligible workers who are unemployed through no fault of their own, or work-related misconduct. Further, eligible workers must be willing and able to work, and actively looking for work. In Arizona, some workers may be eligible for extended unemployment insurance during a period of high unemployment if you exhaust your regular benefits. You may be required to meet special work search or other eligibility requirements while on extension.
