

Does your business development strategy include providing goods and services to the Federal government? Creating a profile in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) and the Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS) and keeping it current ensures that your firm has access to federal contracting opportunities, especially those for small businesses. Entering your small business profile data into CCR allows you to populate the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Supplemental Pages, known as DSBS, where your business information and capabilities statements can be viewed by contracting officers, large prime contractors, and the general public.

The Small Business Administration provides financial, technical and management assistance to help Americans start, run, and grow their businesses. The SBA has <u>small business size standards</u> that your firm must meet to be considered a small business. Please note that if you are interested in receiving Small Disadvantaged Business, HUBZone, or 8(a) certifications, you will need to apply to the SBA for certification.

The Congress created the Small Business Administration in 1953, to "aid, counsel, assist and protect, insofar as is possible, the interests of small business concerns." SBA provides financial, technical and management assistance to help Americans start, run, and expand their businesses. Go to the SBA website for more information.





If your company has merged, split, or simply changed its name, you must alert your contracting officer to accomplish a novation modification on any current contracts. This is an important step, as your payment on current contracts could be negatively impacted if the novation process is not completed. Please contact your contracting officer for details. Additionally, please note that any changes made to your company name in CCR when you have open contracts require contacting your contracting officer for a Novation Agreement.

The federal government does NOT provide grants for starting and expanding a business.

Government grants are funded by your tax dollars and therefore require very stringent compliance and reporting measures to ensure the money is well spent. As you can imagine, grants are not given away indiscriminately.

Grants from the federal government are only available to non-commercial organizations, such as non-profits and educational institutions in areas such as, medicine, education, scientific research and technology development. The federal government also provides grants to state and local governments to assist them with economic development.

Some business grants are available through state and local programs, non-profit organizations and other groups. For example, some states provide grants for expanding child care centers; creating energy efficient technology; and developing marketing campaigns for tourism. These grants are not necessarily free money, and usually require the recipient to match funds or combine the grant with other forms of financing such as a loan. The amount of the grant money available varies with each business and each grantor.

If you are not one of these specialized businesses, both federal and state government agencies provide financial assistance programs that helps small business owners obtain low-interest loans and venture capital financing from commercial lenders.




