## A BILL

  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

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SECTION 1. CONTINUING USE OF 3-MONTH QUARTER EHR
REPORTING PERIODS FOR PROFESSIONALS
AND HOSPITALS TO DEMONSTRATE MEAN INGFUL USE FOR 2015 UNDER THE MEDICARE
AND MEDICAID EHR INCENTIVE PAYMENT
PROGRAMS.

7 In specifying the EHR reporting period under part 8 495 of title 42, Code of Federal Regulations, for purposes of titles XVIII and XIX of the Social Security Act, the 9 10 Secretary of Health and Human Services shall continue 11 through 2015 (in the case of eligible professionals) and 12 fiscal year 2015 (in the case of eligible hospitals and critical access hospitals) to permit the use of a 3-month quar-13 ter EHR reporting period to demonstrate meaningful use 14 for purposes of such part, without regard to the payment 15 16 year or the stage of meaningful use criteria involved.
