## **House Student App Contest**

- The contest is opened to high school students who reside in the FL-22 Congressional District.
- Participants may compete individually or in groups of up to 4 students.
  - For groups of 2 students at least 1 must reside in the FL-22 Congressional District.
  - For groups of 3-4 students at least 2 must reside in the FL-22 Congressional District.
- Students can verify that they live in the district by going to <a href="https://www.pbcelections.org/precinctfinder.aspx">https://www.pbcelections.org/precinctfinder.aspx</a> and selecting My Districts
- Students may submit their entries between the dates of February 1, 2014 at 12PM EST to April 30, 2014 12PM EST
- To submit an entry:
  - After February 1, 2014 create an account on <a href="http://challengepost.com/">http://challengepost.com/</a> and register for the House Student App Contest
  - Create an App Demonstration Video of no more than 2 minutes that demonstrates the scope and quality of the app.
  - Create a Developer Video of no more than 1 minute in which the participant describes how they created the app and what they learned.
  - Upload both videos to YouTube or VIMEO and submit the links through http://challengepost.com/
  - Submit an entry form through http://challengepost.com/
