

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4681
OFFERED BY MR. HIMES OF CONNECTICUT

At the appropriate place in the bill, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . ANNUAL REPORT ON VIOLATIONS OF LAW OR EX-**
2 **ECUTIVE ORDER.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title V of the National Security
4 Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3091 et seq.), as amended by sec-
5 tion 309, is further amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 **“SEC. 510. ANNUAL REPORT ON VIOLATIONS OF LAW OR EX-**
8 **ECUTIVE ORDER.**

9 “(a) ANNUAL REPORTS REQUIRED.—The Director of
10 National Intelligence shall annually submit to the congress-
11 sional intelligence committees a report on violations of law
12 or executive order by personnel of an element of the intel-
13 ligence community that were identified during the previous
14 calendar year.

15 “(b) ELEMENTS.—Each report required under sub-
16 section (a) shall include a description of, and any action
17 taken in response to, any violation of law or executive
18 order (including Executive Order 12333 (50 U.S.C. 3001
19 note)) by personnel of an element of the intelligence com-

1 munity in the course of such employment that, during the
2 previous calendar year, was determined by the director,
3 head, general counsel, or inspector general of any element
4 of the intelligence community to have occurred.”.

5 (b) INITIAL REPORT.—The first report required
6 under section 510 of the National Security Act of 1947,
7 as added by subsection (a), shall be submitted not later
8 than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (c) TABLE OF CONTENTS AMENDMENT.—The table
10 of sections in the first section of the National Security
11 Act of 1947, as amended by section 309 of this Act, is
12 further amended by adding after the section relating to
13 section 509, as added by such section 309, the following
14 new item:

“Sec. 510. Annual report on violations of law or executive order.”.
