ALG Urges House to Adopt Balanced Budget in Five Years

May 23rd, 2011, Fairfax, VA—Americans for Limited Government President Bill Wilson today issued a statement urging the House to pass <u>legislation by Rep. Jack Kingston that would balance the budget in five years</u>:
