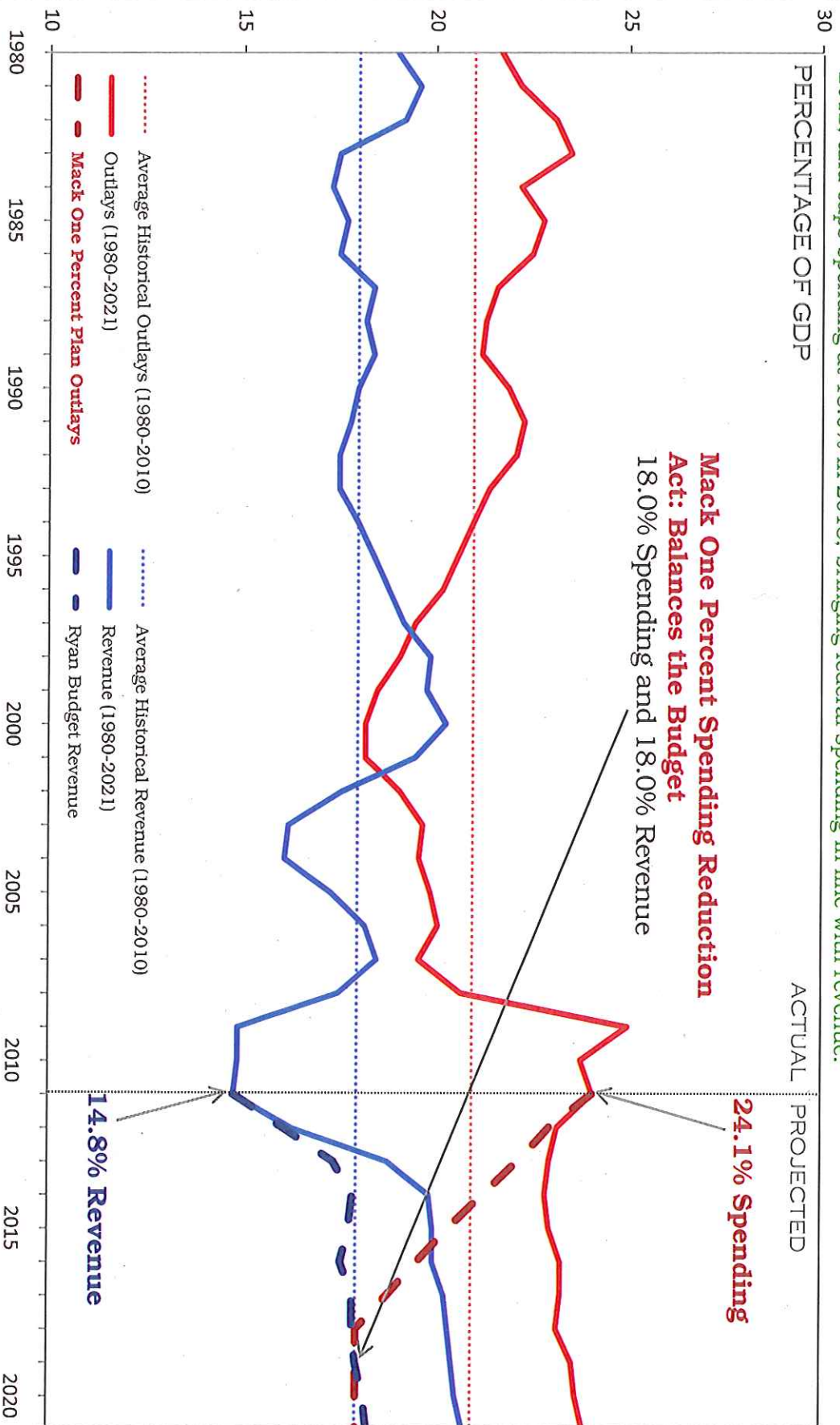


Federal Spending and Revenue

The Mack One Percent Spending Reduction Act will put America onto a path of greater economic freedom by balancing the federal budget in the near-term. This plan reduces total spending by one percent each year for six years, beginning in 2012, and caps spending at 18.0% in 2018, bringing federal spending in line with revenue.
