Page 28, line 15, strike "Except as provided in paragraph (k), it" and insert "It".

Page 29, strike lines 5 through 20 and insert the following:

1	(4) It shall not be in order to consider a general
2	appropriations bill if such measure does not include
3	a section at the end (before the short title) as fol-
4	lows:
5	"SPENDING REDUCTION ACCOUNT
6	"Sec (a) The amount dedicated to spending
7	reduction shall equal the amount submitted for printing
8	in the Congressional Record by the chairman of the Com-
9	mittee on the Budget. (b) The amounts in this account
10	shall not be available, in any fiscal year, for appropriation,
11	obligation, expenditure, or transfer.".
12	(5) Allocation adjustments.—(A) Upon the
13	engrossment of an appropriation bill and for pur-
14	poses of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974—
15	(i) the chairman of the Committee on the
16	Budget shall change the section 302(a) alloca-
17	tion established under such Act by the amount

1	of new budget authority and outlays reduced
2	and dedicated to spending reduction; and
3	(ii) if an adjustment is made under sub-
4	paragraph (A), the chairman of the Committee
5	on Appropriations shall change the section
6	302(b) suballocations established under such
7	Act for such bill by the amount of new budget
8	authority and outlays reduced and dedicated to
9	spending reduction.
10	(B) Upon the filing of a conference report in
11	the House or for consideration of amendments be-
12	tween the Houses, if the rule on such measure pro-
13	vides for a reduction in the amounts dedicated to the
14	spending reduction account and the House adopts
15	that rule, for purposes of the Congressional Budget
16	Act of 1974—
17	(i) the chairman of the Committee on the
18	Budget shall change such section 302(a) alloca-
19	tions established under such Act; and
20	(ii) if an adjustment is made under sub-
21	paragraph (A), the chairman of the Committee
22	on Appropriations shall change the section
23	302(b) suballocations established under such
24	Act for such measure.

## [Discussion Draft]

(C) As used in this section, the term "appro-
priation bill" means any general or special appro-
priation bill, and any bill or joint resolution making
supplemental, deficiency, or continuing appropria-
tions.
(6) Publication.—The chairman of the Com-
mittee on the Budget shall maintain and publish in
the Congressional Record the amounts in the spend-
ing reduction account by appropriations bill and any
adjustments made to section 302(a) allocations
under this section.
