Checklist:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. Official high school transcript with ranking and college transcript (if necessary)
- 3. Three letters of personal recommendation (old fashioned reference letters, from a teacher, counselor, coach, or your clergy –anyone who knows you best, but not a family member) Letters do not have to be sealed.
- 4. One page essay (at least) on why you want to attend a service academy
- 5. Resume or summary of your extracurricular activities
- 6. Two recent color photographs (billfold size head shot such as a school picture or passport picture) with your name and home town on the back.
- 7. SAT/ACT scores (if you will indicate code number **6969** on the SAT test, the testing institute will forward the scores directly to us. Use code **7702** for the ACT.) We will accept a copy of your scores and scores printed on high school transcripts.

Students may submit single items as finished, rather than mailing the entire packet all at once. Once your file is complete, you will receive written confirmation by mail.

Personal interviews will be conducted by Congressman Smith's Selection Board the first weekend in December. All nominees will be notified before Christmas.

It is important that you start an admissions file at *each* academy in which you are interested. If you have not done so, the websites have been provided so you can fill out the preliminary application online. To receive a nomination to an academy you must have a file open at that academy at the time of the interviews.
