## WHAT DO I NEED TO COMPLETE MY DACA APPLICATION?

- A cashier's check or money order for \$465 made out to U.S. Department of Homeland Security
- Two (2) passport-style photos (available at Walgreens, CVS and other locations)
- A list of the addresses where you have lived SINCE FIRST ENTERING the U.S.

## • Documents that prove you meet the DACA requirements, as listed in the chart below.

Please note:

- Documents in a foreign language should be accompanied by a certified English translation these translations can be done by anyone who is bilingual and signs an appropriate certification statement OR obtained at most currency exchanges and notaries.
- If you have been arrested or appeared in front of a judge for anything other than minor traffic violations you must obtain a copy of your criminal record and/or court disposition(s).
