I am writing to express our support for the concurrent resolution you and other Members plan to introduce opposing a carbon tax. As you know, the U.S. economy cannot afford a new tax that would lower economic growth, increase energy prices, disproportionately hurt low-income families, destroy jobs, put U.S. industry at a competitive disadvantage in world markets, and provide an incentive for companies to move overseas. In addition, we do not believe a carbon tax is an economically feasible way to manage greenhouse gas emissions.
