

**Amendment to H.R. 1126**  
**Offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah**

On page 1, after line 8, insert the following:

“(1) Subsection (c) is amended—

(A) in paragraph (2) by striking “Members of the Senate” and inserting “persons”; and

(B) in paragraph (3), by striking “Members of the House of Representatives” and inserting “persons”.

On page 2, line 1, strike “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

On page 2, lines 4, 10, and 24, and on page 3, line 7, strike “(2)” and insert “(3)”.

On page 2, line 9, strike “(3)” and insert “(4)”.

On page 2, line 23, strike “(4)” and insert “(5)”.

On page 2, strike lines 6 through 8 and insert instead:

“(f) APPOINTMENTS.--Each appointment of a Commission member shall be made in consultation with the Eisenhower Foundation, a Section 501(c)(3) public foundation located in Abilene, Kansas.”.

On page 2, line 20, strike “designs submitted or” and insert “design”.

On page 3, strike lines 6 through 14.

Page 3, line 15, strike “(c)” and insert “(b)”.

On page 3, after line 20, insert the following:

“(c) COMMISSION TERMINATION; STAFF; RECORDS.—

- (1) The membership of the Dwight D. Eisenhower Commission in existence on the date of the enactment of this Act shall terminate on the date of enactment of this Act. New members of the Commission shall be appointed in accordance with Section 8162 of Public Law 106-79, this Act and the amendments made by this Act.
- (2) The Executive Director and the staff of the Dwight D. Eisenhower Commission in existence on the date of enactment of this Act shall cease to be employed by the Commission on the date that is 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
- (3) Any records of the Commission in existence on the date that the staff is no longer employed by the Commission under paragraph (2) shall be retained by the General Services Administration or the Secretary of the Interior until such time as a new Dwight D. Eisenhower Commission is appointed. The records of the former Commission shall be transferred to the newly appointed Commission as soon as possible.”.
