

H.R. 4870 – The FY 2015 Department of Defense Appropriations Bill

House Adopted Amendments

Lee (D-CA) – The amendment increases funding for Research, Development, Testing and Evaluation (RDT&E) within the Defense Health Program by \$5 million, offset by a reduction in Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance. The intent of the amendment is to designate funding for Multiple Sclerosis research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jackson Lee (D-TX) – The amendment increases Defense Health RDT&E funding by \$500,000, offset by a reduction to the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. The intent of the amendment is to support Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Lamborn (R-CO) – The amendment increases funding for the Army National Guard Operation and Maintenance account by \$5 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. The intent of the amendment is to support the Army National Guard Southwest Border Mission. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jeffries (D-NY) – The amendment increases RDT&E within the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account for the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support programs that help with recuperation from trauma caused by violence, including PTSD. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

McKinley (R-WV) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$21 million within the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. The intent of the amendment is to support the National Guard Youth Challenge program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

McGovern (D-MA) – The amendment increases the Operation and Maintenance account within the Defense Health Program by \$3.5 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account by the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support a service dog pilot program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Benishek (R-MI) – The amendment increases Defense Health RDT&E funding by \$2 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account by the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support Alzheimer's research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Ellison (D-MN) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$10 million within the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. The sponsor's intent is to support the Office of Economic Adjustment. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Runyan (R-NJ) – The amendment increases funding to Other Procurement, Air Force account by \$6 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account of

the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support joint training and training development at Air Force facilities. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Delaney (D-MD) – The amendment increases funding for a Department of Defense (DoD) grant to the Fisher House Foundation by \$16 million, offset by a \$24 million reduction to the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Lowenthal (D-CA) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$5 million from the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account. The intent of the amendment is to support DoD’s STARBASE program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Operation and Maintenance account of the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support Gulf War Illness research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Murphy (R-PA) – The amendment increases the Operation and Maintenance account within the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a \$37 million reduction in the Air Force Environmental Restoration account. The intent of the amendment is to support mental health and anti-suicide programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jackson Lee (D-TX) – The amendment increases the Defense Health Program by \$5 million, offset by a reduction in the Defense-Wide Procurement account by the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support breast cancer research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Nugent (R-FL) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$10 million within the Air Force RDT&E account. The intent of the amendment is to support the Counter-Electronics High Power Microwave Missile Project. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment increases the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction the Defense-Wide RDT&E account of the same amount. The intent of the amendment is to support prostate cancer research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Holt (D-NJ) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$1 million within the Defense Health Program. The intent of the amendment is to support mental health research on financial stress. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Langevin (D-RI) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$30 million within the Defense Health Program. The intent of the amendment is to support the Spinal Cord Injury Research Program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Holt (D-NJ) – The amendment cuts, then adds back, \$2 million within the Intelligence Community Management Account. The intent of the amendment is to provide additional

resources for the Inspector General to manage a whistleblower and source protection program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Daines (R-MT) – The amendment strikes language in the bill that sunsets a provision prohibiting DoD from reducing or decommissioning Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) silos. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to award a contract to a company that has been convicted of, or is currently indicted/civilly charged for a range of crimes, or has delinquent taxes of more than \$3,000 within a three-year period of the offered contract. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Walorski (R-IN) – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to transfer Guantanamo Bay detainees to the country of Yemen. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 238-179.**

Nolan (D-MN) – The amendment prohibits funding in the bill for the Afghanistan Infrastructure Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Miller (R-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding in the bill to divest, retire, transfer, or place into storage any A-10 aircraft, to prepare for such activities, or to dissolve any A-10 units. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 300-114.**

Cotton (R-AR) – The amendment prohibits funds to transfer or release Guantanamo Bay detainees to any country. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 230-184.**

Runyan (R-NJ) – The amendment prohibits funding to retire, divest, or transfer the entire KC-10 aircraft fleet during fiscal year 2015. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Walberg (R-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding to promulgate Directive 293 issued by the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

DeLauro (D-CT) – The amendment prohibits funding to award contracts to corporations incorporated or chartered in Bermuda, the Cayman Islands, or Ireland that were previously incorporated in the United States. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Fleming (R-LA) – The amendment prohibits funding to appoint military chaplains who do not have an endorsing agency. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Flores (R-TX) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement, administer, or enforce section 526 of the Energy Independence and Security Act, which prohibits federal agencies from procuring certain fuels unless the greenhouse gas emissions are less than conventional petroleum sources. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Conyers (D-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding to transfer man-portable air defense systems to any entity in Syria. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

McKinley (R-WV) – The amendment prohibit funding for the Administration's climate change agenda, which includes the National Climate Assessment, the IPCC report, the UN's Agenda 21, and the Social Cost of Carbon. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Hanabusa (D-HI) – The amendment prohibits funding for Iraq in contravention of the War Powers Resolution. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Nugent (R-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to plan for or carry out a furlough of a dual-status military technician. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Speier (D-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement an amendment to Executive Order 12473 of April 13, 1984, as those amendments apply to Section 405(i) of the Rules for Courts-Marshall. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding for the storage of patrol boats under Navy Memorandum #105-E2P-196 dated October 12, 2010. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Rogers (R-AL) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement the Open Skies Treaty. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Murphy (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding to maintain or improve DoD real property that the Department lists as being completely unused, with certain exceptions. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funds to procure Army Air Crew Combat Uniforms. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Ellison (D-MN) – The amendment prohibits funding to award contracts to any person who has violated certain wage requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 212-204.**

Forbes (R-VA) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement the Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on their Destruction. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

McClintock (R-CA) – The amendment prohibits funding for green energy programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Grayson (D-FL) – The amendment prohibits funding for DoD and the NSA to consult on certain information security standards in a manner that contravenes a section of existing law. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Wittman (R-VA) – The amendment prohibits funding for an additional BRAC round. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Jackson Lee (D-TX) – The amendment prohibits funding from being used in contravention of Article II, section 2 of the Constitution. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

King (R-IA) – The amendment prohibits funding to transfer weapons to the Palestinian Authority. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Massie (R-KY) – The amendment prohibits funding for certain queries under section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence and Surveillance Act, and prohibits funds for the government to request that products or services support lawful electronic surveillance. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 293-123-1.**

Barrow (D-GA) – The amendment prohibits funding to disestablish, close, downgrade, or place on probation a Senior ROTC program in accordance with a Department of the Army information paper. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Conaway (R-TX) – The amendment prohibits funding to enter into a contract for the planning, design, refurbishing, or construction of a biofuels refinery, unless specifically authorized by law. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Kildee (D-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding from being used in contravention of Sec. 1034 of title 10, United States Code. This statute relates to the rights of members of the military to contact their Member of Congress or the Inspector General. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Gosar (R-AZ) – The amendment prohibits funding to the Government of Iran, the Government of Syria, the Palestinian Authority, Hamas, or the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 280-133.**

Huizenga (R-MI) – The amendment prohibits funding to implement a Small Business Administration regulation concerning the definition of “small business” for footwear manufacturers. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
