H.R. 4487– The Legislative Branch Appropriations Act House Adopted Amendments

<u>Speier (D-CA)</u> – The amendment directs \$500,000 to the Congressional Office of Compliance, offset by an equal reduction in the Architect of the Capitol General Administration Fund, to require sexual harassment training for all House offices. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment cuts funding for the Botanic Gardens by \$3.2 million and transfers the funds to the Spending Reduction Account. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 219-198.**

<u>Hall (R-TX)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to deliver printed copies of the Statement of Disbursements produced by Chief Administrative Officer to any Member office. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Wenstrup (R-OH)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used for the delivery of printed copies of the House of Representatives Daily Calendar to Member offices. This document is available online. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**
