Making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2011, and for other purposes.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives

3 That the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Public

4 Law 111–242) is further amended—

(1) by striking the date specified in section
 106(3) and inserting "April 8, 2011"; and
